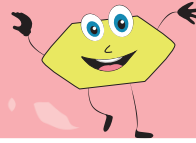


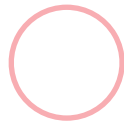

Jack has 3 cars. His brother gives him 1 more car. How many cars does Jack have now?

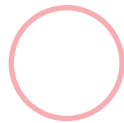

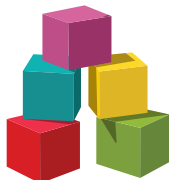
Emily has 2 books. She gets 3 more books. How many books does Emily have now?

Tom has 5 blocks. He picks 2 more blocks. How many blocks does Tom have now?

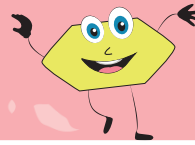

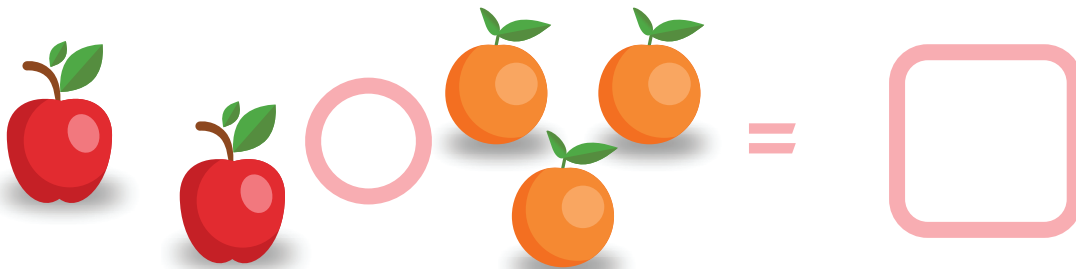

There are 2 apples and 3 oranges. How many fruits are there in total?



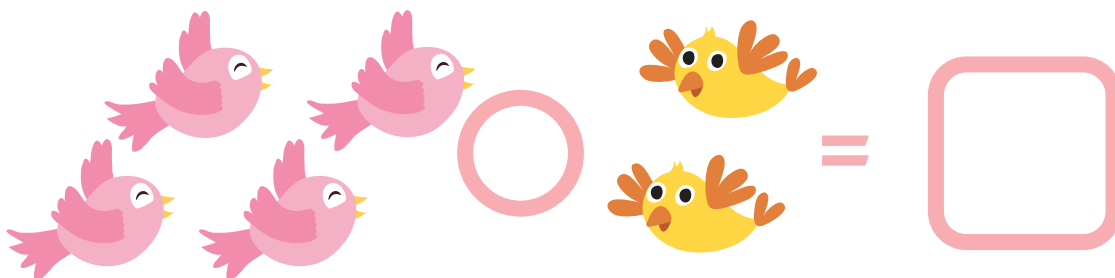
Q2

There are 4 birds, and 2 more birds come. How many birds are there in total?



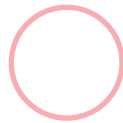

Mia has 3 balloons. She gets 2 more balloons. How many balloons does Mia have now?

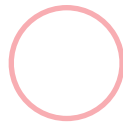

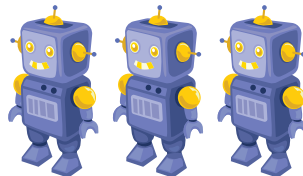
There are 4 cupcakes. 1 more cupcake is added. How many cupcakes are there in total?
